5 things you can COUNT on:

1

The laws surrounding IEPs and Section 504 plans remain unchanged; they have not been repealed, and there are no waivers. Federal and state timelines are still in effect.

2

Parents and families should continue to advocate for the services their children need.

3

Schools must continue to follow IDEA and Section 504 laws and work with parents to determine how services can be effectively delivered.

4

Schools need to ensure that students with special education needs get the support they require, whether they're learning in a school building or remotely.

5

Parents can still request an IEP team meeting at any time.
