WHAT is TNSTEP?

TNSTEP is a statewide not-for-profit established in 1989 serving Tennessee families. We are Tennessee's PTI - Parent Training and Information Center.

WHO do we help?

WHAT does TNSTEP offer professionals?

HOW much does it cost?

- ★ FREE if parents and caregivers are invited
- ★ FREE if funded by grants from the Tennessee Department of Education
- ★ Fee-for-service but very cost effective
