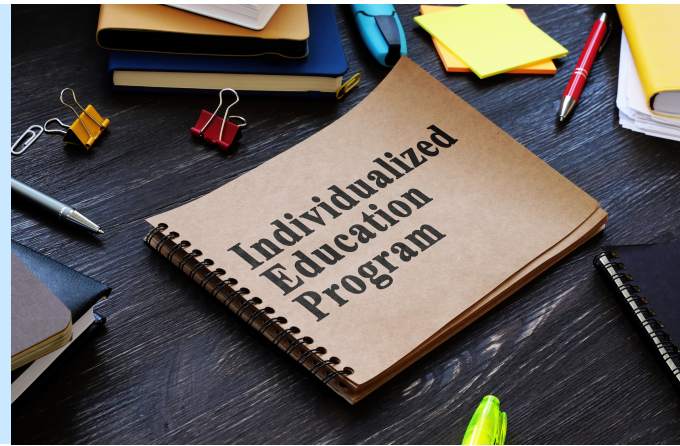


THE NEXT STEP - IEP PLANNING
